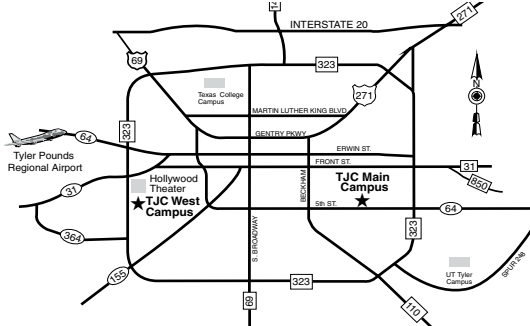

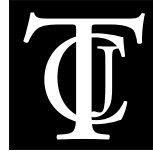

The 2008 TJC Apache soccer team and nationally recognized coaching staff will hold their annual Residential Summer Soccer Camp for Boys, Girls, and Goalkeepers July 9-13 at TJC's Pat Hartley Field, the premier soccer facility in East Texas.



Tyler Junior College and PUMA annually present this five-day camp to teach players, ages U-12 and up, advanced skills and tactical progressions for the world's fastest athletic team sport.



Camps are designed with the objective to teach skills in a unique station-training system, focusing on individual and team techniques in game conditions.

Players are grouped by age and skill level to provide the greatest development and instruction. Goalkeepers will train individually and with teams under the supervision of an NSCAA Advanced National Goalkeeping staff. Each team will be trained by various collegiate coaches (DI, DII, DIII, NAIA).

### THE COACHING STAFF

Camps are under the direction of Steve Clements, TJC Head Coach and 2000 National Coach of the Year.

Clements has directed the Apache soccer team and TJC Spring and Summer Soccer camps since 2002. College coaches from throughout the nation and players from the Apache soccer team assist with camp instruction.



Clements guided the Meridian Community College (MS) Eagles to the NJCAA Division I National Championship and was named NJCAA Coach of the Year after a 24-1 season.

He has coached at the club, high school and collegiate level and has held World Cup Soccer Camps for 18 years, instructing more than 1,200 girls and boys annually in 21 locations throughout Mississippi, Alabama and Louisiana, before moving to Tyler.

### THE CURRICULUM

- Topics include:
- Individual skills
  - Small and large group tactics
  - Defensive principles – technical & tactical
  - Attacking principles – technical & tactical

*Elite team training is available upon request.*

### WHAT TO BRING

- Soccer shoes, shin guards, and sunscreen
- Tennis shoes (or flats) with 5 days of field and casual attire
- Single-bed linens and a shower curtain
- Toiletries (including toilet paper) and towels
- Money for concessions, snacks, laundry, etc.

### THE CAMPS/TUITIONS

All camps are for ages U-12 and up, and meet from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Campers will receive a TJC soccer ball, PUMA T-shirt, water bottle, and applicable accommodations and meals, as well as individual and team evaluations.
